

Senator Ted Gaines Spring 2017 video contest rules for entry

- This contest is open to all high school or undergraduate students living in or attending school within the boundaries of the 1st Senate District, a map of which can be found [here](#).
- Students may work in groups, but only one video is allowed per entrant. If you work in a group, please designate one student as the designated contact.
- Videos should be between 2 minutes and 5 minutes long.
- All entries should begin with a 5 second title screen (which does not count against total time) that includes:
 - Student's name (or designated contact if working in a group)
 - School name
 - School address
 - Title of video
 - Total running time (not including 5 second title screen)
- No copyrighted video, images, or audio may be used.
- All videos must be submitted in digital format to senator.gaines@senate.ca.gov with the subject line "Video Contest Submission"
- Entries must be received no later than 5PM on Friday, May 26th, 2017
- No professional assistance is allowed. Parents, teachers, professors, and others may give verbal advice, operate the camera, or appear in the production, but may not otherwise assist.
- The attached entry form must be submitted along with the video.
- The theme of the Spring 2017 contest is "How American Exceptionalism made California Golden"
- Contest finalists and winners will be chosen by Senator Ted Gaines at his sole discretion.
- Videos must comply with all laws, must not invade the privacy of any person, and must not contain any inappropriate content.
- Winners will be decided in two categories, High School and College.
- Winning students or groups will receive a \$300 prize and be invited to the State Capitol in Sacramento for a meeting with Senator Ted Gaines and a VIP tour of the historic building.
